Abstract: The Peter van Dyck collection includes correspondence, reports, presentations, meeting agendas and minutes, MCH audiovisual materials, news items, planning documents, preparation and background materials, surveys, proposals, guidelines, grant award announcements, evaluation summaries, Title V Information System data, statistics, journal articles, MCHB budgets, testimony, legislation, information on federal programs and federal-state partnership initiatives, speeches, appointment calendars, and MCHB meeting, training, and travel-related materials. Although the bulk of the materials reflect the work activities of Dr. van Dyck during his years with MCHB (1992-2011) and those immediately preceding it, the collection includes papers dating back to van Dyck's years as director of the Family Health Services Division of the Utah Department of Health and professor of pediatrics at the University of Utah Medical Center. The collection includes selected federal government and other publications dating back to 1914.

Biographical/Historical Note

Dr. Peter van Dyck served as acting associate administrator for the Maternal and Child Health Bureau (MCHB), U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, beginning August 3, 1998, and was appointed to associate administrator in 1999. Prior to that, he was the first permanent director of MCHB's Office of State and Community Health (OSCH), which was created to be more responsive to state issues related to the MCHB block grant. In this position, he provided guidance to states, established reporting requirements, coordinated technical assistance, and developed national information and data systems. Other responsibilities that fell within the domain of the MCHB Office during this period included the State Systems Development Initiative (SSDI), abstinence education legislation, immunization, health care reform, managed care, and the national media campaign for Healthy Start.

Before joining the federal government in 1992, Dr. van Dyck was the director of the Family Health Services Division of the Utah Department of Health and professor of pediatrics at the University of Utah Medical Center. He was president of the Association of Maternal and Child Health Directors from 1978-1980 and chair of the Maternal and Child Health Section of the American Public Health Association from 1989-1990. In 1999, Dr. van Dyck received the Arthur Flemming Award, given to exceptional federal employees by George Washington University and Government Executive magazine, for computerizing the Title V MCH Block Grant Services Block Grant application and annual report, and for standardizing MCH performance measures. Dr. van Dyck earned a medical degree and Master of Science (MS) degree in physiology from the University of Illinois Medical Center Chicago, and a Master of Public Health (MPH) degree in maternal and child health from the University of California, Berkeley.

For two years, Dr. van Dyck served as Senior Medical Advisor to the director of the Maternal and Child Health Bureau. He also served as executive secretary of the Secretary's Advisory Committee on Infant Mortality and acted as liaison to both the Healthy Start evaluation in the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) and the Medicaid Bureau in the Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA). Van Dyck's priorities were to improve systems of care for maternal and child health populations, with a special emphasis on policy development, outreach and evaluation, and to create innovative strategies for financing that care.

Dr. van Dyck served as associate administrator of MCHB until his retirement in 2011. He was selected as the recipient of the Martha May Eliot Award (2011), which has been presented by American Public Health Association since 1964 to honor exceptional achievements in the field of maternal and child health.

Scope and Content Note:

Although much of this collection reflects the work activities of Peter van Dyck in his capacity as associate administrator of the Maternal and Child Health Bureau (MCHB), many of the boxes contain papers from his earlier years as director of the Family Health

Services Division of the Utah Department of Health and professor of pediatrics at the University of Utah Medical Center. Others relate to his involvement as Chair of national committees such as the Maternal and Child Health (MCH) Section of the American Public Health Association (APHA) and in his role as President of the Association of Maternal and Child Health Directors.

Other boxes in the series reflect the activities of Dr. van Dyck in his role as director of MCHB's Office of State and Community Health, where he was responsible for providing the organizational focus of the administration of the MCH block grant to states program, including guidance, reporting requirements, coordination of technical assistance, and development of national information and data systems for the block grant. Included in the collection are papers related to the State Systems Development Initiative (SSDI) and Abstinence Education legislation. Other files contain papers related to infant mortality, immunization, health care reform, managed care, and the national media campaign for Healthy Start.

The collection also contains materials that reflect Dr. van Dyck's interests in improving systems of care for maternal and child health populations, nationally and internationally, with an emphasis on policy development, outreach and evaluation, and creating innovative strategies for financing health care.
